## LUAU RECIPES

### **Brandy Slush – Carolann Mikesell**

2 small cans orange juice  
2 small cans lemonade  
9 cups water  
2 cups Brandy  
1 cup sugar  
Mix and freeze

To Serve: Scrape frozen slush into glasses and pour Sprite over slush.

### **Mary Collins' Turtle Pie (Serves 12)**

Mix and press in 9" form pan:  
2 cups crushed chocolate wafers (38 wafers)  
1/3 cup butter  
Bake at 350 F for 10 minutes

In heavy saucepan, melt 30 Kraft vanilla caramels with 1/2 cup caramel ice cream topping  
Stir in 1/4 cup heavy cream  
Cool and then pour over chocolate crust  
Spread 2 cups chopped pecans over caramel filling  
Chill 1 hour  
Melt 3/4 cup chocolate chips mixed with 1/4 cup whip cream. Spread over pie and chill 1 hour.

*Plan to exercise at least 1 hour for each slice consumed!*
