Libraries

Getting a Library Card

As a resident of Mt. Pleasant Township, you are eligible for a free library card. The library is located in Yorktown on the southeast corner of State Road 32 and Adaline Street (known as Tiger Drive north of SR 32). Entrance to the library is from Adaline. Proof of address is needed to apply for a card.

The library is small but friendly and does have audio and video tapes as well as books and magazines. It is open from 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. daily and until 2 p.m. on Saturday. It is closed on Sunday.

For \$26.00 per year, you can purchase a PLAT card that gives you access to all state libraries including the Muncie Public Library.

GET READY FOR WINTER

That time of year is fast approaching. Be prepared and protect your home in the following ways.

- ❖ Open cabinet doors to help warm pipes.
- ❖ Allow a slow stream of water to run throughout the night when it is especially cold.
- ❖ Disconnect outdoor water hoses.
- ❖ Keep a clean filter in the furnace.
- ❖ Consider installing heating cables on the roof over enclosed patio rooms.
- ❖ Keep furnace heat set no lower than 65 degrees when you are traveling or living elsewhere during the cold months.
