



## FROM THE BOARD

- \* Please remember to observe the **15 MPH speed limit** in Willow Lake. Remind your guests as well. This is especially important now that many of our neighbors are walking or biking in the area.
- \* The WLHA is responsible for outside maintenance of water lines. There is no need to buy the extra insurance offered by the water company.
- \* Call Wanda Concannon to request work orders for outside maintenance such as weed removal, pruning, etc.
- \* A committee of volunteers is being formed to assist residents who need help with simple jobs such as turning off gas fireplace pilot lights, changing ceiling fan speeds, etc. Volunteers will not do plumbing or electrical work, move furniture or work outside the condo. - \* The gate is currently up in order to allow time for all local emergency units to become familiar with the gate operation.
- \* When using a gas grill, be sure to keep it a safe distance from windows and siding. Heat from grills can break windows and melt siding.

**Sue Conaway** is setting up the rummage sale.

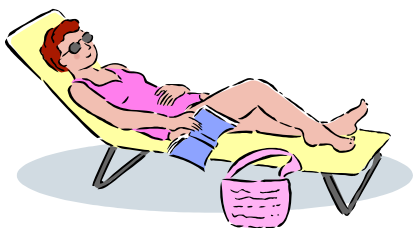
**Wanda Concannon** for taking care of the bake sale table at the rummage sale.
